

Article 1 JCR Membership Order

1 There are three types of membership of the JCR, these are:

1.1 Full Members who shall have the right to:

- 1.1.1 Stand for election to be a JCR Officer subject to any requirements for a particular position,
- 1.1.2 Vote in any Method I or Method II election,
- 1.1.3 Attend and vote in any meeting,
- 1.1.4 Attend meetings of the Executive Committee except during reserve business,
- 1.1.5 Be a proposer or seconder for a motion for any meeting,
- 1.1.6 Join clubs and societies,
- 1.1.7 Attend JCR events, and
- 1.1.8 Use all JCR facilities.

1.2 Honorary Members, who shall have the right to:

- 1.2.1 Attend and vote for a motion at any meeting,
- 1.2.2 Be a proposer or seconder for a motion for any meeting,
- 1.2.3 Attend all JCR events, and
- 1.2.4 Use all JCR facilities.

1.3 Associate Members, who shall have such rights and benefits as they are granted by the motion granting them Associate Membership.

1.4 Those students of Saint Cuthbert's Society who have opted-out of JCR membership shall have the right to:

- 1.4.1 Attend Cuth's Day.

2 Terms of membership

2.1 Upon joining the Society, all Students shall become Full Members.

- 2.1.1 All Full Members shall have the right to opt-out of JCR Membership, this shall be done by:
 - 1) Requesting and completing the appropriate form from the appropriate member of Society staff, or
 - 2) Not paying the JCR Levy by the end of the Michaelmas term.

- 2.2 Any Student who chooses to opt-out of JCR Membership may choose to become a Full Member again by paying their JCR Levy at any time.**
- 2.3 Associate Membership may be granted to an individual or collectively to the members of an organisation by the Members in General Meeting through a motion that is proposed by a Member and seconded by fourteen Members. The motion must specify the length of time for which Associate Membership is granted along with the rights and benefits they are to be accorded by the JCR.**
- 2.4 The amount of the JCR Levy shall be £35 per expected year of study, and the total amount shall be payable during Michaelmas term of a student's first year.**
- 2.4.1 For the avoidance of doubt, Full Members continuing from Undergraduate study into Postgraduate study will be required to pay the JCR Levy again at the beginning of their Postgraduate course.
- 2.5 There shall be a Facilities Charge of £50 payable on arrival to cover the cost of running and maintaining JCR facilities.**
- 2.6 In special cases an application to pay charges in instalments rather than in one payment may be made to the Treasurer and shall be left to his discretion whether to accept or reject the application.**
- 2.6.1 The Treasurer's decision shall be open to an appeal to Governance Committee in the usual manner.
- 2.7 If a member wishes to terminate their membership, they shall only receive a refund of their JCR Levy if the Treasurer receives written notification of the desire to terminate membership before the end of Michaelmas term of the academic year that the JCR Levy was paid.**
